

CLAWDBOT COMPLETE SETUP GUIDE

Your 24/7 AI assistant. 30 minutes. No coding required.

WHAT IS CLAWDBOT?

Clawdbot is an open-source AI assistant that runs 24/7 on a server. You talk to it through WhatsApp, Telegram, Discord, Slack, or iMessage. It doesn't just answer questions — it does actual work. Think of it as your employee, co-founder, and executive assistant rolled into one. It clears your inbox, schedules meetings, researches companies, writes content, manages your calendar — all while you sleep.

BEFORE YOU START

■ Claude subscription — \$20/mo (Pro) or \$100/mo (Max) at anthropic.com ■ Telegram app installed ■ 30 minutes

TIP: Pro works for getting started. Max for heavy use. Alternative: MiniMax 2.1 ~\$10/mo for simple tasks.

STEP 1: GET A SERVER (5 min)

Option A: AWS Free Tier (recommended)

1. aws.amazon.com → Create account → Search "EC2" → Click "Launch Instance"
2. Name: anything ("clawdbot") → OS: Ubuntu → Instance type: search "free" → pick t2.micro (8GB)
3. Key pair: "Proceed without key pair" → Click "Launch Instance"
4. Click Instance ID (blue link) → Click "Connect" (top right) → Click "Connect" again

You're in a terminal. Black screen with text = success.

TIP: AWS free tier = 750 hrs/mo free for 12 months = 24/7 coverage.

Option B: Hetzner (\$4-5/mo)

hetzner.com → Cloud Console → New Project → Create Server → Ubuntu → CX11 (cheapest)

Option C: Mac Mini at home (\$0/mo)

No cloud needed. Runs on your desk 24/7. M1/M4 Mac Minis popular.

STEP 2: INSTALL CLAWDBOT (2 min)

Copy-paste this single command into the terminal:

```
curl -fsSL https://clawd.bot/install.sh | bash
```

Wait ~2 min. Installs Node.js, dependencies, everything. This is the ONLY command you need.

WARNING: If "permission denied" → add sudo in front of the command

STEP 3: RUN THE WIZARD (10 min)

Wizard starts automatically. Follow these selections:

1. Accept risk warning → 2. Quick Start → 3. Anthropic → 4. Token paste setup
5. Wizard shows a command → open NEW terminal on your Mac/PC → paste it → copy the token back
6. Model: "Opus 4.5" (smartest) or "Sonnet 4.5" (faster) → 7. Channel: "Telegram bot"
8. Skip all API keys for now → 9. Install Gateway daemon → yes

TIP: "Unauthorized" error? Try incognito window (cached version issue).

STEP 4: CREATE TELEGRAM BOT (5 min)

Part A — Create the bot:

1. Telegram → Search @BotFather → Send /newbot → Name it ("Jarvis") → Username (must end in "bot")
2. BotFather replies with token → Copy ENTIRE token → Paste into wizard

Part B — Lock to only YOU:

1. Search @userbot → Send /start → Copy the number → Paste into wizard

WARNING: Don't skip this. Without user ID, anyone can talk to your bot.

STEP 5: HATCH YOUR BOT (5 min)

Wizard asks to "hatch" → yes. Open Telegram → find your bot → send "hello"

Answer: What should I call you? (your name) • What should you call me? (bot name) • Purpose? • Timezone?

Your assistant is now alive.

STEP 6: PAIRING CODE (if needed)

If bot sends pairing code: Copy code → Server terminal → Run: clawdbot pairing approve telegram [code]

FIRST WINS & WORKFLOWS

YOUR FIRST 3 WINS (do immediately)

Win 1 — Research: "Research [any company] and give me a 3-bullet summary."
Win 2 — Reminder: "Remind me to [something you've been putting off] tomorrow at 9am."
Win 3 — Content: "Draft a short LinkedIn post about [topic you know well]."
If all three work, you're ready. Now you trust it.

VOICE SETUP (hands-free mode)

You don't have to type. Talk to clawdbot while you walk, drive, cook, or exercise.

"I cycle to the gym — 25 min of dead time. Now I wear a lapel mic and brain dump. Thoughts, tasks, ideas. Clawdbot formats it and takes action." — Neil Stevenson

- Voice notes in Telegram/WhatsApp — hold mic button and talk
- Wispr Flow app — voice dictation that sends to clawdbot automatically
- Lapel mic + voice memo → send recording to clawdbot
- Meta Ray-Ban glasses — see something, ask about it via WhatsApp

REAL WORKFLOW EXAMPLE

Chain tasks together (all by voice while doing other things):

1. "Analyze my website for SEO" → 2. "Research AI crawlers I should allow" → 3. "Update my metadata"
4. "Write a blog post about this" → 5. "Create a slide deck" → 6. "Draft LinkedIn post"
7. "Draft Twitter thread" → 8. "Create a downloadable cheat sheet as lead magnet"

Set it off, come back to finished work. Run multiple agents in Slack — they work in parallel.

ADDING SKILLS & INTEGRATIONS

Skill 1: Web Search (add first)

Brave: brave.com/search/api → get free key → tell bot "Set up Brave search with this API key: [key]"
Exa MCP (free, no key): Tell bot "Create a skill by wrapping this MCP: [Exa link]"

Skill 2: Connect Your Tools

GitHub	PRs, code review, issues	Gmail	Read/send, summarize inbox
Calendar	Schedule, availability	Drive	Read/write docs, search
Vercel	Auto-deploy sites	Obsidian	Sync notes, search
Spotify	Playback, playlists	Smart Home	Lights, thermostat

TROUBLESHOOTING

Stuck anywhere	Screenshot → ChatGPT → "What do I do?"
Something breaks	Tell bot: "fix this" + paste error
Bot not responding	Run: clawdbot gateway status
"Unauthorized"	Try incognito browser
Pairing code	Run: clawdbot pairing approve telegram [code]
Check setup	Run: clawdbot doctor
Restart	Run: clawdbot daemon restart

COST SUMMARY

Claude Pro + AWS Free	\$20/mo	Getting started
Claude Max + AWS Free	\$100/mo	Heavy use
MiniMax + Hetzner	~\$15/mo	Budget option
Claude Max + Mac Mini	\$100 + \$0	Power users

Context: Human VA = \$500-2000/mo and sleeps 8hrs. Clawdbot runs 24/7 for \$20.

"Research [person] before my meeting – background, recent activity, talking points"

"Compare [product A] vs [product B] – features, pricing, reviews"

CALENDAR & PRODUCTIVITY

"Monitor my Sentry for errors and create GitHub issues for new ones"
"Set my Tesla to 72 degrees and unlock the doors"
"Build me a CLI tool that [does X] and publish it to npm"
"Analyze my Google Analytics and tell me what content is working"
"Create a skill that [does X] and add it to my workspace"

MULTI-STEP WORKFLOWS

"Research [topic], write a blog post, create social posts, and schedule them"
"Analyze my competitors, create a comparison chart, draft an email to prospects"
"Review my calendar for next week, identify conflicts, suggest reschedules"
"Scrape [job board] for [role], filter by [criteria], export to spreadsheet"
"Monitor [news source] for [topic], summarize daily, alert me on big news"
"Take my meeting notes, extract action items, create tasks, send summary to team"
